When challenged by Gillibrand on an op-ed he wrote about working mothers, Biden defends his policy record, including initiating the "It's On Us" pledge for college campuses. "You came to Syracuse University with me and said it was wonderful," he says. "I don't know what's happened, except that you're now running for president."

Color Guard + Vocalist | *National Anthem* **8:06 p.m.**

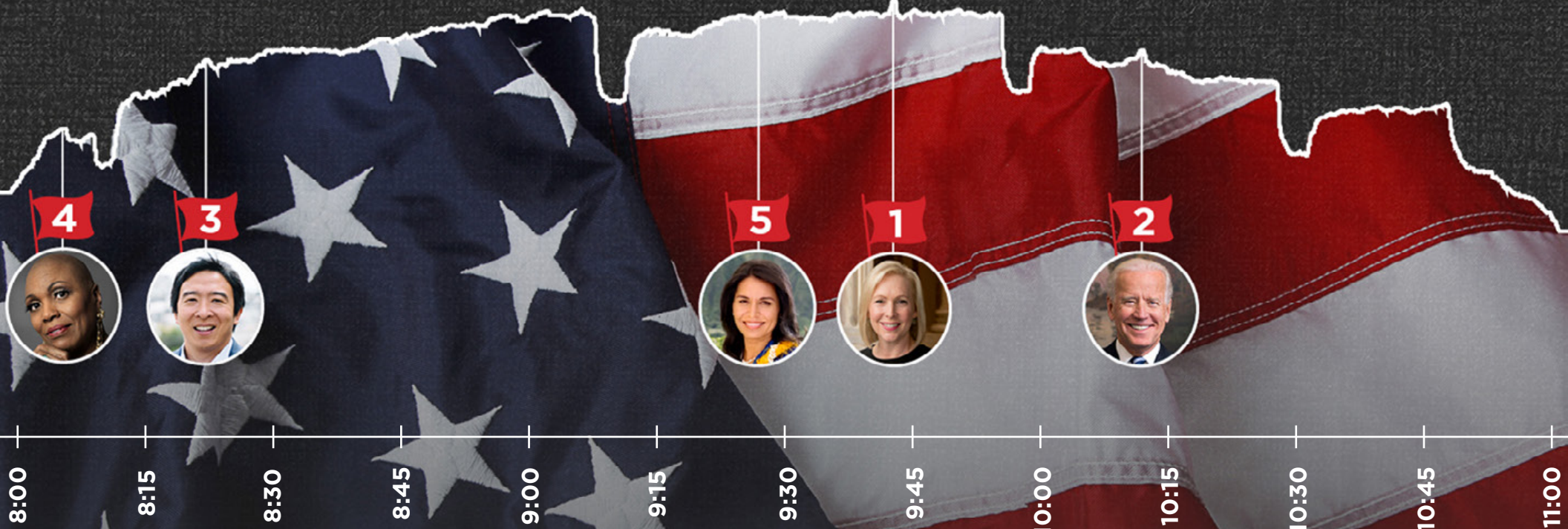
Jazz singer and Flint, Michigan native, Dee Dee Bridgewater, performs the national anthem.
